- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 2.6% since 2019, growing by 1,640. Population is expected to increase by 1.4% between 2024 and 2029, adding 937.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 1.6% in Carbon County, PA from 18,065 to 18,349. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.1% to 60.2% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.0% of Carbon County**, **PA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.5% below the national average), and **11.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.4% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Other Amusement and Recreation Industries.









Unemployment by Ethnicity






Population Trends






Millennials

Carbon County, PA has 11,204 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 13,300.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Carbon County, PA. The national average for an area this size is 19,760 people 55 or older, while there are 25,249 here.




Racial Diversity

Violent Crime


Carbon County, PA has 1.8 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.








Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Occupation Employment Concentration




