
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 11.8% since 2019, growing by 6,615. Population is expected to increase by 8.3% between 2024 and 2029, adding 5,166.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 6.7% in Pike County, PA from 13,547 to 14,451. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 3.9% by 2.8%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 54.4% to 48.4% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.5% of Pike County, PA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.0% below the national average), and **10.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Traveler Accommodation.









Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends






Pike County, PA had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 4.08%, decreasing from 5.50% 5 years before.




Millennials

Pike County, PA has 9,652 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 12,444.




Retiring Soon Racial Diversity


Veterans

Pike County, PA has 0.36 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.54 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime






Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Employment Concentration








Top Industry GRP




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




